Directions: Choose any famous nursery rhyme. go to Office.com for powerpoint. Username@absstudents.abs.misd.net if you do not have access to it you can do this one paper too

1. Select your nursery rhyme. Random name generator will determine the order each group gets to pick.
2. Research your nursery rhyme. When was it written, is there a story behind it, why was it written, was it written for a certain time in history etc. Try to find about 3-5 facts about the rhyme.
3. Create a PowerPoint for your nursery rhyme research. Slide 1 should be the nursery rhyme with graphics to help support it (characters, themes, etc). If you need more than 1 slide that is ok.
